



BREAKDOWN OF LOOKED AFTER POPULATION AS OF 31ST MARCH 17

- 490 CHILDREN CURRENTLY IN FOSTERCARE SERVICES
- 213 CHILDREN IN MAINSTREAM FOSTERCARE
- 254 IN KINSHIP CARE
- 23 PRIVATE FOSTERCARE





KINSHIPCARE BREAKDOWN OF AGE GROUPS

AGE OF CARERS

18 - 30 YRS = 18

30 - 40 YRS = 34

40 - 50 YRS = 53

50 - 60 YRS = 65

60 + YRS = 33

(98 OF OUR KINSHIP CARERS ARE OVER 50 YEARS OF AGE = 48%)

CHALLENGES FACING OLDER KINSHIP CARERS IN THE WHSCT

KINSHIP ASSESSMENT FRAMEWORK

- INITIAL SW CONTACT
- WORKING WITHIN A SYSTEM
- VIABILITY ASSESSMENT WITHIN 48 HOURS IF CHILD PLACED ON AN 'IMMEDIATE BASIS'
- WEEKLY ASSESSMENT SESSIONS (12 16 WEEKS)
- PRESENTATION TO PANEL
- MONTHLY VISITS BY SUPPORTING KINSHIP WORKER
- ANNUAL REVIEWS





CARERS FEEDBACK

- "I HAVE ALWAYS CARED FOR MY GRANDCHILD, WHAT HAPPENS IF I FAIL THIS ASSESSMENT"
- "I AM NOW IN THE ROLE OF GRANNY, MAMMY AND DADDY, IM WEARING THREE HATS"
- "I HAVE NEVER HAD TO HAVE A SOCIAL WORKER IN MY LIFE BEFORE, THERE ARE SO MANY PROFESSIONALS AND MEETINGS. CAN I NOT JUST GET ON WITH IT"
- "I KNOW THE KIDS NEEDS ARE NOW THE PRIORITY BUT I CANT STOP WORRYING ABOUT MY DAUGHTER, I LOVE HER EVEN THOUGH SHE CANT STOP...."





AGE AND HEALTH OF KINSHIP CARERS

- "THE CHILDREN KEEP ME FEELING YOUNG"
- "I WORRY ABOUT MY FINANCES WHEN I REACH PENSION AGE AND HOW THIS WILL AFFECT US"
- "JUST BECAUSE MY SIGHT IS NOT GOOD DOESN'T MEAN I CAN'T LOOK AFTER MY GRANDCHILD"
- "EVEN THOUGH WE DO NOT KEEP THE BEST WE WANT TO KEEP THE CHILDREN IN THE FAMILY WHERE THEY BEONG. NOBODY CAN LOVE THEM LIKE WE DO"
- "I DON'T UNDERSTAND SELF EMPLOYED THAT HMRC KEEP SAYING, IM CARING FOR MY GRANDKIDS"





HOME CONDITIONS – ACCOMMODATION/SPACE

- "MY HOUSING IS BEST SUITED TO US AS PENSIONERS AND WE REALLY DON'T HAVE ENOUGH ROOM, BUT WE DON'T WANT TO BE REHOUSED TO KEEP THE CHILDREN"
- "I HAVE AGREED TO SLEEP ON MY SOFA IN THIS EMERGENCY"
- "I HAVE LIVED HERE ALL MY LIFE, NOW I HAVE TO MOVE TO A NEW AREA THAT I DONT KNOW"

WHAT CARERS SAY

- "I'M THEIR GRANDAD, I HAVE TO DO THIS"
- "THIS WASN'T WHAT WE WERE PLANNING BUT IT'S THE RIGHT THING TO DO"
- "WHAT HAPPENS IF I DONT, THEY WILL END UP WITH STRANGERS"





DILEMMAS

 WE NEED TO TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION HOW KINSHIP CARE, OCCURS, UNDERSTAND OUR KINSHIP CARERS AND THEIR STORIES TO HELP US SUPPORT AND MAKE THE RIGHT DECISIONS FOR CHILDREN.

- WORK IN PARTNERSHIP WITH KINSHIP CARE NI
- UNDERSTAND THE DIFFICULTIES KINSHIP CARERS FACE
- SIGNPOST
- LISTEN & ADVOCATE WORKING WITH THE TRUST CAN BE DAUNTING
- VISIT MONTHLY OR MORE FREQUENTLY IF REQUIRED
- SUPPORT IF RESIDENCY ORDER IS AN OPTION
- MONTHLY SUPPORT GROUP
- TRAINING
