This seminar reports on the first ever survey of public attitudes to Armed Forces veterans conducted in Northern Ireland. The Armed Forces module of questions in the Northern Ireland Life and Times Survey was funded by the Forces in Mind Trust. Issues covered include attitudes towards previous military action in Northern Ireland, attitudes towards veterans who served in conflicts outside of Northern Ireland, perceptions of military veterans' wellbeing, and services provided to veterans in the region.

The Life and Times Survey is an annual survey recording the attitudes of the public of Northern Ireland to a wide range of social issues. The 2017 survey included questions relating to respect; good relations; minority ethnic groups; migrant workers; community safety and perceptions of paramilitary influence; political attitudes and BREXIT.
