- Comparison of organisation membership between under/over 65 age groups.

### Office of the First Minister/Deputy First Minister

- The circumstances of older households, households with children and households in poverty.
- Comparison of poverty levels in NI with other areas in the UK.

### Department of Finance and Personnel, Northern Ireland

• To calculate the impact on households in Northern Ireland of the introduction of a new rating system – identifying the winners and losers.
