The Northern Ireland Life and Times Survey is a resource for anyone interested in the social attitudes of people living in Northern Ireland. The survey runs annually and records public opinion on a wide range of social issues - from politics to pensions, and from education to the environment.

On the website you will find tables of results for every question, as well as the questionnaires and publications relating to the survey. The datasets can be downloaded for people who want to work with the data themselves, and we also provide a helpline for users.

The Northern Ireland Life and Times Survey is part of the ARK resource - dedicated to making social and political information on Northern Ireland available to all. The ARK website holds information on a wide range of social and political topics. With research summaries, survey results, visual material, facts and figures, it is an essential starting point for anyone who needs to gather information on Northern Ireland quickly and easily.
