




Do you think the long-term policy for Northern Ireland should be for it...




(NILT, 2018)

- Don't know




If there was a referendum tomorrow about whether Northern Ireland ..., how do you think you would vote? (2017)





The growth of those who are 'neither' unionist nor nationalist (1998-2018)






Generally speaking, do you think of yourself as Nationalist,



Does the UK leaving the EU make a United Ireland more likely?




(by unionists, nationalists and Neithers, 2018, %)



Does the UK leaving the EU make a United Ireland more likely?




(as viewed by those who are Neither unionist nor nationalist, 2016-18, %)
