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



# Do you think climate change is caused by natural processes, human activity or both? (NILT, 2024, %)




Most see human activity as being the primary cause of climate change.






#### Leaver





## Difference between those supporting different parties (NILT, 2024, %)




How much do you agree or disagree that you want to see the politicians elected ...do more to tackle climate change? (NILT, 2024, %) (by party supported)

DUP supporters less keen for political action



## **Summary**

- Northern Ireland is one of the most climate-sceptical regions in Europe
- Yet a clear majority of respondents (8 out of 10) believe that climate change poses a serious threat to the future of human civilisation and want to see states cooperate internationally to address it.
- Brexit: Leave voters are far more likely than Remain voters to be sceptical about climate change and far less likely to feel concerned about it or to wish to see action to address it.
- **Party:** DUP supporters' views on climate change are significantly different to those of other Executive parties in Northern Ireland, being far more sceptical of climate change and less concerned to see action to tackle it.
- **Gender:** men personally less worried, less keen to see political action, and less likely to feel a sense of personal responsibility to address it than women.
- Rural/Urban: rural dwellers less likely to trust scientific experts on the topic and less convinced it poses a serious threat.
- **Age:** Younger people (18-34 years) are more trusting of scientific experts but less likely to feel a sense of personal responsibility or enthusiasm for political action to address climate change
