Shared Education (YLT and KLT)  
School Bullying (YLT and KLT)  
Healthy Eating and Lifestyles (KLT)  
Wellbeing and Self-Esteem (KLT)

This event is predominantly for organisations, researchers and school staff who work with and on behalf of children and young people.
